

KJV Psalm 106: 37 Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils, 38 And shed innocent blood, *even* the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.

KJV Proverbs 24:10 *If* thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength *is* small. 11 If thou forbear to deliver *them that are* drawn unto death, and *those that are* ready to be slain; 12 If thou sayest, Behold, we knew it not; doth not he that pondereth the heart consider *it?* and he that keepeth thy soul, doth *not* he know *it?* and shall *not* he render to *every* man according to his works?

Getting Started

1. What problem, similar to abortion, existed in Bible times? Who was guilty of it? What does God call it? (Ps. 106:37-38)

2. What responsibility, if any, do Christians have in this issue since we may not be directly involved with a pregnancy? (Pr. 24:10-12; c.f. Exodus 1:16-17).

3. What haunted Carol's mind following her abortion? What promise had she made to Tom that precipitated her decision? What overlooked element in the abortion crisis does Tom's promise reveal? (74-75)

4. Name some things Carol did in order to suppress her guilt. (76-78)

5. What industry did Carol get sucked into? What has her primary motivation for running and expanding the business? (78)

6. What major event began to soften Carol's callous heart and turn her against the abortion industry? (79-80)

7. What important message did Jack have for Carol at their first meeting and what was Carol's response? What prediction did he make about her business? (84)

8. What was different about Carol the very next day after meeting Jack? What did she pray at the end of the day? (85-86)

9. How did God show Carol that He meant business and bring her out of the abortion industry? (88)

10. Where did Carol find forgiveness for all the abortions she helped perform? What new clinic business is Carol now involved in? (90-91)
